

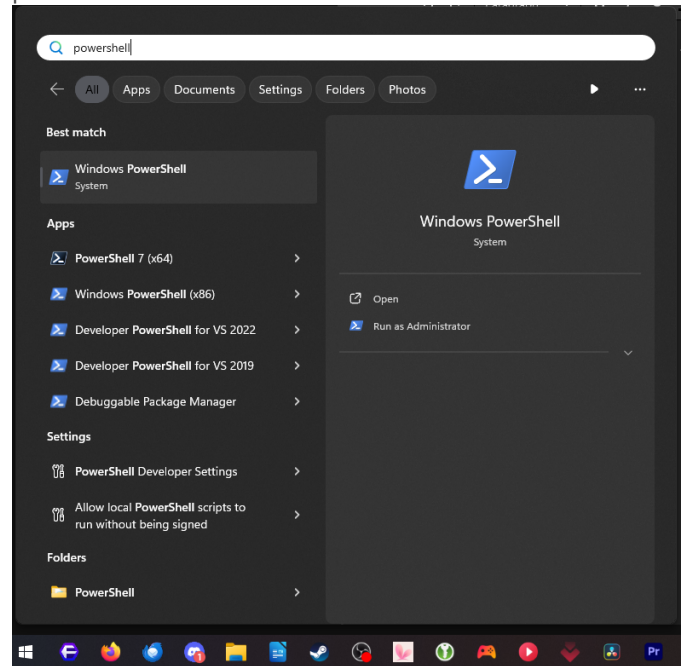

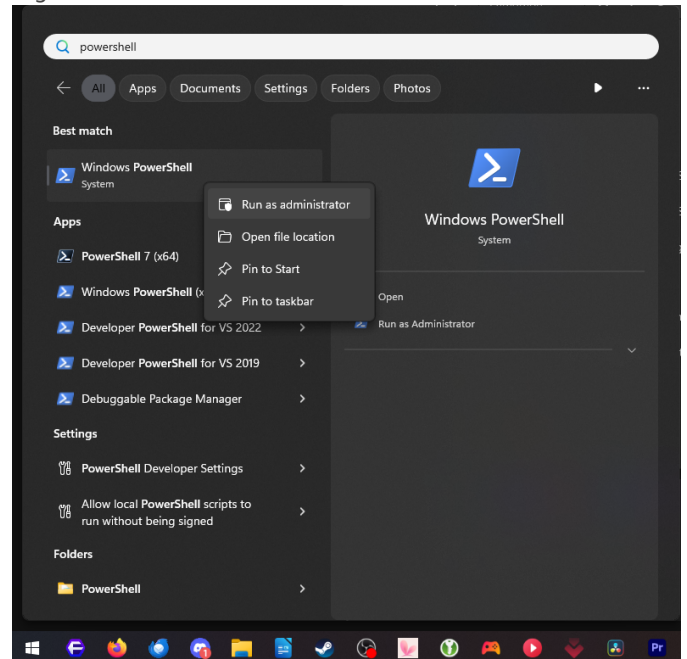

## Steps to Correct:

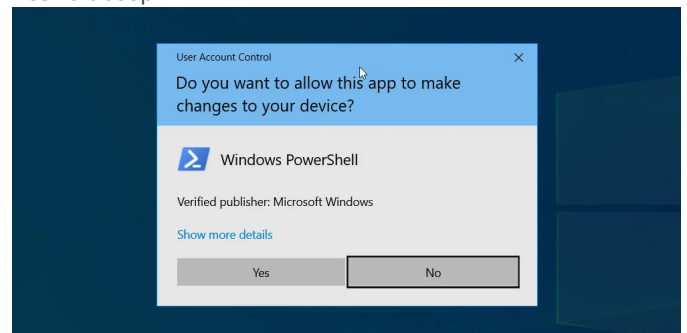
Hit your Windows key on your keyboard and type in powershell.



Right-click and run as administrator.



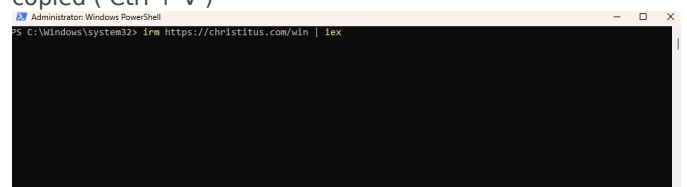
If you get a UAC prompt to allow Powershell to run, press Yes to accept it.
